Head. Head clothed largely with narrow decumbent and borbits and large patches of flat yellowish scales almost at tip, slightly swollen at tip. Palpi narrowly white-tipped, with flat pale scales but without hairs; first flagellar segment not

and broader erect scales above, both types of scales yellowish; narrow yellowish scales on meeting at vertex. Proboscis sprinkled with pale scales above, largely pale beneath except nearly a quarter as long as proboscis. Pedicel (Pe) clothed

much longer than second.










Bionomics: Found in rather open swamps.
