**BRAND NAME OR TRADE NAME:**  
The name of the product, used to help identify a specific product.

**ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:**  
What chemicals in this product affect the pests sprayed? What other chemicals does this product contain?

**SIGNAL WORD:**  
How toxic is this to me?  
**DANGER** = Very Toxic  
**WARNING** = Moderately Toxic  
**CAUTION** = Least Toxic



**TARGET PESTS:**  
What pests will this product control?  
What life stage will it control?

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:**  
Where do I keep this when I am not using it? What do I do when I no longer need it?

**FIRST AID:**  
What do I do if I accidentally get this on me or in my mouth or in my eyes?



**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**  
How do I use this product?  
How much can I apply?  
How often can I apply it?  
Where am I allowed to use it?  
Where can I not use it?  
What should I not do?

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:**  
How do I use this product safely? Will it hurt my pets? Will it kill my plants?

**EPA REGISTRATION NO.:**  
Is a unique identification number given to the product by the US EPA to verify a product has been found safe and effective in controlling labeled pests.

It's important to always read and follow the label before using a pesticide product. The label is the law!
