## **ENVIRONMENTAL SAMPLING FOR SARS-COV2 IS NOT STANDARD PRACTICE**

Environmental sampling for Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome-Coronavirus-2 (SARS-CoV-2) is not feasible nor recommended at this time. To date, there are no validated, commercially available, environmental test methods specific for infectious SARS-CoV-2 viruses in air or on surfaces. Additionally, there are no procedures in place that will permit data interpretation necessary to establish a level of contamination or to evaluate the effectiveness of cleaning and disinfection within buildings.

Environmental sampling to verify effectiveness of cleaning and disinfection is not currently included in the guidelines published by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), World Health Organization (WHO), American Industrial Hygiene Association (AIHA) or other public health authorities. Currently, the U.S. Army Public Health Center (APHC) is advising Army facilities to implement practices and procedures identified by the CDC, AIHA, or APHC for cleaning and disinfection.

Many of those infected with SARS-CoV-2 are "silent spreaders." Testing surfaces can verify their cleanliness only until a space is re-occupied and potentially re-contaminated. This is why public health professionals recommend routine, not episodic, cleaning and disinfection for most buildings.

Leaders and supervisors should provide oversight to confirm that cleaning and disinfection procedures are properly followed.
